BOARD OF DEACONS

"Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit; and there are varieties of services, but the same Lord; and there are varieties of activities, but it is the same God who activates all of them in everyone."

The Book of Order describes the ministry of deacon as one of compassion, witness, and service, sharing the redeeming love of Jesus Christ for the poor, the hungry, the sick, the lost, the friendless, the oppressed, those burdened by unjust policies or structures, or anyone in distress.

So, what do the Deacons at First Presbyterian Church in Conrad do? The most visible task of the deacons is to make sure that the church building is open and ready for Sunday service, and to act as greeters and hand out bulletins. On Communion Sundays, the Deacons prepare the elements and the communion table. Along with these very visible tasks, the deacons also contribute to our church family and the Conrad community in the following ways:

- Hosted a spaghetti supper fundraiser, silent auction, and auction to benefit a family in our community who had lost their home to a fire.
- Organized meals for 8 households, as well as Meals on Wheels tickets and a luncheon for a family gathering for a funeral.
- Helped to provide desserts for Norman Stordahl's funeral luncheon at Pondera Valley Lutheran Church.
- Financial assistance requests for utilities, electrical repair, fuel, overnight lodging at a motel, diapers, bottles, and share in the cost of a replacement appliance, along with assistance provided by the Pondera Food Pantry for emergency food needs.
- Handmade Easter cards sent to members of our congregation, as well as our annual Christmas card crafting to go with 20 plates of homemade cookies and gift bags delivered to members of the congregation, Beehive Home, and Logan Health Extended Care.

As you can see, being a member of the Board of Deacons is more than handing out bulletins on Sunday morning. The Board of Deacons is an important representative of our congregation to the community that we call home.


